- Commencing late August/September 2011 for approximately 2 months
- One day per week, Monday-Friday
- Option to work on site or remotely

The internship will involve:

- Researching e-learning tools being utilized in similar organizations, eg. DPI, Bureau of Animal Welfare, RSPCA UK, etc
- Identifying the e-learning that is going on in the School System - Primary, Secondary and Tertiary
- Identifying e-learning Government initiatives and/or support services
- Researching and analyzing available software/programs and making recommendations
- Developing some suggestions for potentially implementing some simple/cost effective e- learning processes through the RSPCA Education department to expand the organisation's access to regional Victoria and to learners who are not able to access our services

The successful intern will have a graduate qualification, preferably in education; an IT background; strong writing skills; an understanding of research processes; e-learning experience and an understanding of its implementation in an educational setting.
