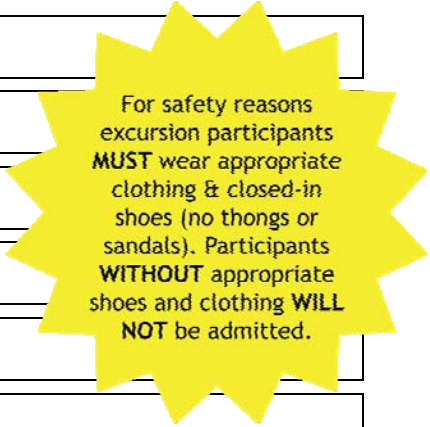

- Agricultural Studies | Years 9-VCE.** Immerse students in the rich history of RSPCA and agricultural animal welfare issues. Also included in discussions are animal related careers and diseases.
- Animal Science | Years 7-10.** How Science fits into an animal welfare organisation. Topics include: classification; feral cats in our ecosystem; dog breeds; and animals in research.
