

DON'T FORGET TO INCLUDE INSTRUCTIONS IN YOUR WILL FOR THE CARE OF YOUR PET!

Leaving clear instructions in your Will is the best way to ensure your final wishes for the future care of your pets are carried out. You can share this sample wording with your solicitor at your next meeting:

“Regarding the future care of my pets, at the time of my passing should there be no member of my family or any of my friends able to properly care for my surviving pets, I direct that my Executor give my surviving pets to The Royal Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (Victoria) (“RSPCA”) on the condition that my pets be found loving new homes under RSPCA’s pet legacy service, or other equivalent program or policy in place from time to time. I further direct my Executor to arrange for the transportation of my surviving pets from their current residence to an agreed RSPCA site.”

Take this with you when you next see your solicitor. And remember, we’ll need a copy of your Will for our records.

I give to the Royal Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (Victoria) ("RSPCA") of 3 Burwood Hwy, Burwood East, Victoria, 3151 (ABN 56 749 449 191): the residue of my estate; OR XX per cent of my estate; OR the sum of \$XXXXX for the general purposes of the RSPCA. I declare the receipt of the RSPCA will be sufficient discharge for my Trustees.
